Descriptive Note:	The Art & Travel Club was formed on February 28, 1922 by a group of prominent Reidsville women. Meetings were held on Tuesday of each week. Rules included fines for being tardy (5 cents), absent (10 cents), and failing to get up material for the program (25 cents, later raised to \$1.00). The club was disbanded on April 5, 1984 after 62 years of existence.
Contents:	Materials consist of 24 record books containing member names, attendance rolls, and minutes of business conducted at each meeting. Also included are receipts, programs, correspondence, financial records, bank books, bank statements, a history of the club, a copy of the constitution, and photographs.
