Descriptive Note: The Biven Collection consists of period items of Jimmie Bivens

from his years at Reidsville High School, his navy career, and his father's WWII years. It includes annuals, newspaper clippings, a diploma, a football program, scrapbooks of high school items and WWII items, and a class ring. The items were donated by a family member to the Reidsville Public Library who in turn donated them to the Rockingham County Historical Collections

in 1996.

Biographical Sketch: Jimmie Douglas Bivens was born in Burlington, NC on

September 17, 1938. He was the only child of Pearcy Quenton Bivens and Nina Turner Bivens. His father, a truck driver, was born in Lexington, NC in 1920 and died in Reidsville, NC in 1972. His mother, Nina Turner Bivens (1917-1988) was a native of

Rockingham County and was employed as a textile worker and later as a nurse's aide. The family settled in Reidsville about 1947 and for many years resided on Barnes St.

Jimmie "Tim" Bivens attended Reidsville High School and graduated in 1956. He served in the U.S. Navy for 4 years then attended Guilford College and graduated with a degree in accounting. He moved to High Point and worked for Ladd Furniture Industries for 15 years. He never married and died at age 57 in High Point on July 1, 1996.
