1 letter, dated December 8, 1819 detailing a dispute in 1805 over a state treasury shortfall involving Willis Alston, John Haywood, John Craven and Sherwood Haywood and signed by M. Hall who had spoken to parties involved

1 receipt, dated November 23, 1816, John Haywood

1 document with heading "House of Commons, 16<sup>th</sup> December 1819" with a proposal by U. S. Congressman Willis Alston to deposit state monies into banks instead of housing it in the State Treasurer's office

1 napkin with drawing of High Rock Farm
