Descriptive Note: Alfred Jackson Ellington was a prominent Rockingham County citizen

who served as a Captain in the Reidsville Light Infantry and the North Carolina State Guard, Co. D. His company did duty in Cuba in 1899 during the Spanish American War, according to the *Reidsville Review* issue of 4/7/1899. Ellington was also a tobacco auctioneer and in 1901 he accepted a position at Cabell's Warehouse in Danville, Va.

Ellington was born in Rockingham County on August 31, 1848, to Richard Alexander Ellington (1818-1884) and Martha Amanda

Whittemore (1823-1882). He married Caroline "Kate" Gray Bonner in

1855 and had 6 children:
