| <b>Descriptive Note:</b>   | Robert Fryar (1804-1873) and Barbara Garringer Fryar (1811-1892) were married in 1830 and lived on a farm near Gibsonville, North Carolina. They had four sons, Boston, Peter, John and Henry. This family appears in the 1850 U. S. Census as the "Robt Trier" family, Northern Division, Guilford, North Carolina. Barbara sometimes appears as Barbery Fryar. Robert and Barbara are buried at the Friedens Lutheran Church cemetery in Gibsonville. |
