- U. S. Army discharge, James H. Carroll, Private, Co. C, 1<sup>st</sup> Reg., North Carolina Volunteers. Dated April 22, 1899. Notes on back read "Served during the Spanish American War 1898 in Cuba. Character excellent, service honest and faithful."

U. S. Dept. of the Interior, Bureau of Pensions, certificate authorizing pension for James H. Carroll, Private, Co. K, 27 Reg. United States Infantry, dated November 18, 1912. Glued to the certificate are 2 newspaper clippings. The first describes 1800 Austro-Hungarian prisoners of war in East Siberia who thanked "the officers of the 27<sup>th</sup> regiment of the great American nation" for saving their lives during an outbreak of influenza. The second mentions the 27<sup>th</sup> being re-equipped after losing all in a Galveston storm. They were preparing to depart for Manila.

U. S. Dept. of the Interior, Bureau of Pensions, certificate authorizing Lula F. Carroll, widow of James H. Carroll \$30.00 per month pension plus \$6.00 per month for each child to commence June 30, 1928. Children listed were Blanche E., Barney A., and Ernest M.
