Born in 1877 in Patrick County, Va., Edwards married Martha "Susie" Snead in that county in 1899. By 1915, they resided in Leaksville, N.C. and Jesse Ben was a mill worker at the American Warehouse in Spray, N. C, perhaps helping to build the smokestack at the mill. Edwards was acquainted with the legendary singer and banjo player, Charlie Poole. Edwards died September 29, 1959 in Leaksville, and was buried in Meeks Cemetery.
