**Descriptive Note:** The Junior Order United American Mechanics was formed in

1853 as a nativist organization. Their major goals as stated in

their bylaws were:

"To maintain and promote the interest of Americans and shield them from the depressing effects of unrestricted immigration, to assist them in obtaining employments, and to encourage

them in business."

"To provide for the creation of a fund or funds for the payment

of donations in case of sickness, disability or death of its

members, to member, their legal dependents or

representatives."

"To uphold the American public school system, prevent interference therewith, and to encourage the reading of the Holy Bible in the schools thereof."

"To promote and maintain a national orphan's home."
