Descriptive Note:	A small collection of North Carolina Public School Registers for the Wentworth area dated 1895-1910. The registers came from a trunk in the possession of Rudy Dallas Wilson. Cornie Sikes, mentioned in one of the registers, married Charlie Dallas. She owned land at Skyline Drive in Greensboro and was related to the Paisley family.
Contents:	One school register dated 1895-1899. Includes listings of colored students from District 15 and District 3, School No. 5. Includes name, age and sex. The teacher's contracts inside are

signed by W. T. Lomax.

One school register dated 1907-1908 for District 10, white children of Wentworth, NC, grades 1 through 7. The teacher's contract inside is signed by Miss Cornie Sikes. Student names are listed along with age and sex.

One school register dated 1909-1910 for District 3, white children of Wentworth, NC. Teacher's contract inside is signed by Miss Minnie Meador. Student names are listed along with age and sex.
