<b>Descriptive Note:</b>	This collection of items was found in an old house in Reidville by a person who then donated it to Lillian Coleman of the Rockingham County Historical Society, who then donated it to the Rockingham County Historical Collections. Much of the collection consists of personal correspondence addressed to Thomas J. Oliver of Hightower (Caswell County). By 1925, Oliver had moved to Burton Street in Reidsville and was likely employed by Edna Cotton Mill. The letters were written by friends and relatives in Danville, Reidsville and Altamahaw. No other information is known about the Olivers.
