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
### **FALL 2020 ENROLLMENT FACTS**

- A total of 1,931 students enrolled during the fall of 2020. This is a decrease of 4% from the fall of 2019, but an increase of 8% from the fall of 2016.
- Of these students, 60% are seeking an associate degree, 5% are seeking a diploma, less than 1% are seeking a certificate, 17% are enrolled in Early College High School, 17% are Career and College Promise, and 2% are seeking special credit.
- Career and College Promise enrollment is down 4% from the fall of 2019, but is up 198% from the fall of 2016.
- A total of 1,246 students (64.5%) are female, compared with 1,226 (60.8%) in 2019 and 1,075 (62.1%) in 2018.
- In the fall of 2020, minority enrollment comprised 35.8% of the total enrollment, compared to 34.3% in the fall of 2019, and 31.8% in the fall of 2018.
- The current average age is 21.94, compared with 21.98 in the fall of 2019, and 22.5 in the fall of 2018.
- A total of 538 (27.9%) students are enrolled full-time, compared to 660 (32.7%) in the fall of 2019, and 605 (34.9%) in the fall of 2018.
- Most of our students are from Rockingham County with 80.7% (1,558) listing it as their county of residence. Guilford county makes up 10.4% (200), Caswell County makes up 3.1% (60), and out of state residents make up just 0.7% (13) of the fall enrollment.








