Comments:

- While most medical assistants seek voluntary certification, no state requires medical assistants to be licensed.
- Most states <u>do not</u> have a formal education requirement for medical assistants. Formal medical assisting training programs are available from community colleges, vocational schools, and technical institutes.
- Formal medical assisting programs typically lead to either a certificate or a diploma. They do not confer any type of medical assistant license. Medical assistants <u>are not</u> required by law to hold licensure or certification.
- Medical assisting is not typically a state-licensed/certified profession. This means that medical assistants
 do not typically need specific credentials to practice in the field. The only exception to this includes
 medical assistants who perform specific duties, such as phlebotomy or x-rays, as state laws may require
 specific training and certification in these areas.
