ADVANCED EMT APPLICATION PROCESS

- STEP 1: Complete the RCC application available at https://www.rockinghamcc.edu/admissions-aid/apply/.
- STEP 2: <u>Schedule an appointment</u> to talk with an admissions counselor to discuss the Advanced EMT program requirements and application process.
- STEP 3: Send your official high school or GED transcript to the Admissions Office. Official transcripts can be emailed to transcripts@rockinghamcc.edu.
- STEP 4: After your appointment, submit the Advanced EMT Candidate Review Form and required documentation to the Admissions Office.

All items are required in order to apply for the program.

- o Official high school or GED transcript on file with the Admissions Office
- o Copy of government-issued photo ID (i.e., driver's license, passport)
- o Copy of current EMT certification
- Affiliation Letter (if affiliated with NC Fire/Rescue/EMS agency)
- STEP 5: You will be contact regarding your application status. Admitted students will be registered for the class. Payment is due prior to the first day of class.

ADVANCED EMT COURSE DESCRIPTION

The primary focus of the Advanced Emergency Medical Technician is to provide basic and limited advanced emergency medical care and transportation for critical and emergent patients who access the emergency medical system. This individual possesses the basic knowledge and skills necessary to provide patient care and transportation. Advanced Emergency Medical Technicians function as part of a comprehensive EMS response, under medical oversight. Advanced Emergency Medical Technicians perform interventions with the basic and advanced equipment typically found on an ambulance. The Advanced Emergency Medical Technician is a link from the scene to the emergency health care system. Graduates will be eligible to sit for the North Carolina or National Registry Advanced EMT Cognitive Exam.
