Candidate Review Form Information

The Fall 2022 LPN to ADN Candidate Review Form is a web-based application. Candidates will complete the form, upload required documents, sign and electronically submit. RCC Admissions will begin accepting Candidate Review Forms beginning *Friday, December 17, 2021*.

Fall 2022 LPN to ADN Application Process:

- 1. **Application and Transcript.** Submit your RCC application and NC residency (RDS). Request all official transcripts, including high school/GED and all colleges attended.
- 2. Submit the LPN to ADN Candidate Review Form and upload all required documentation. The form will open Friday, December 17, 2021.

The deadline to submit the Candidate Review Form and documentation is Monday, February 21, 2022 @ 5pm

- 3. Schedule a Candidate Review Appointment with the Assistant Director of Enrollment Services to review and finalize your application. Appointments will take place on Zoom. You will receive the scheduling link after submitting the Candidate Review Form.
- 4. Attend your Candidate Review Appointment on Zoom to review your application materials. After all components of your application are confirmed during the appointment, your application will be submitted to the Nursing Department for review.

The deadline to complete the Candidate Review Appointment is Monday, February 28, 2022 @ 5pm



Required Documents for Candidate Review Form Submission:

The Candidate Review Form will require the attachment of the following documents. Please gather these files *prior* to beginning the Candidate Review Form.

- NACE Score Report from NLN Portal
- Spring 2022 Course Schedule (if enrolled in any pre-requisite courses at another institution) *Students enrolled in classes at RCC **do not** need to submit a schedule*
- Current American Heart Association CPR card
- LPN License Verification from the <u>NC State Board of Nursing</u>
