



Curriculum Course Codes

Course codes are listed as Subject-Course-Section Number

Ex: ENG-111-1451

The section number determines several course identifiers.

Below are the identifiers for the LAST two digits
of the section number – course type.

01-39

Daytime Traditional Class:

Class times are between
8 am – 5 pm

100% of the instruction is delivered
face-to-face in a classroom.

70-79

Evening Traditional Class:

Classes start after 5 pm

100% of the instruction is delivered
face-to-face in a classroom.

50-59

Daytime Hybrid/Blended Class:

Class times are between 8 am – 5

Use a combination of online and
face-to-face class to deliver content

80-89

Evening Hybrid/Blended Class:

Classes start after 5 pm

Use a combination of online and
face-to-face class to deliver content

40-49

Online Class:

100% of instruction is delivered online
via the internet

95-99

HyFlex Class:

Flexible structure for students

100% of the course information is offered face-to-
face AND 100% online offering students a flexible
structure. Students can change their mode of
attendance depending on need or preference.

Below are the identifiers for the FIRST two digits of the section number – course duration.

00

16-week course

Starts with the beginning of the semester

14

14-week course
(aka “late start”)

Begins 2-weeks after the semester starts

08

First 8-week course

Starts with the beginning of the semester, but only lasts 8 weeks

28

Second 8-week course

Starts in the middle of the semester and only lasts 8 weeks

What about SUMMER course codes?

Summer courses can be taken in 8-week classes or 4-week classes.

Below are the codes to distinguish.

First 2 digits: 08 = 8-week, 04 = 1st 4-week session, 24 = 2nd 4-week session

What about WINTER course codes?

Winter courses are 4-week classes and all online.

The code for winter classes will be 4440.

Let's decode an example:

ENG-111-1451

Subject: ENG = English

Course: 111 = Writing & Inquiry

Section: 1451

- Duration: 14 = 14-week term
- Type/Time: 51 = hybrid, daytime

Let's decode an example:

CIS-110-2440

Subject: CIS = Computer Information Systems

Course: 110 = Introduction to Computers

Section: 2440 (Summer!)

- Duration: 24 = second 4-week term
- Type/Time: 40 = online

Course codes are listed as Subject-Course-Section Number
For example: ENG-111-1451, here 1451 is the section number.

The section number determines several course identifiers.

Below are the identifiers for the LAST two digits of the section number which identifies course type.

- 01-39 signifies a daytime traditional class. Classes are offered between 8 am and 5 pm. 100% of instruction is delivered in a face-to-face classroom environment.
- 40-49 signifies an online course where 100% of the instruction is delivered online via the internet.
- 50-59 signifies a daytime hybrid or blended course. Hybrid/blended courses use a combination of online and face-to-face class to deliver instruction. Classes are offered between 8 am and 5 pm.
- 70-79 signifies an evening traditional course. 100% of instruction is delivered in a face-to-face classroom environment. Classes start after 5 pm.
- 80-89 signifies an evening hybrid or blended course. Hybrid/blended courses use a combination of online and face-to-face class to deliver instruction. Classes are offered after 5 pm.
- 95-99 signifies a HyFlex course. This type of course offers a flexible structure for students. 100% of the course information is offered face-to-face AND 100% online offering students a flexible structure. Students can change their mode of attendance depending on need or preference.

Below are the identifiers for the FIRST two digits of the section number which identifies course duration.

- 00 signifies a 16-week course which starts with the beginning of the semester.
- 08 signifies a first 8-week course which starts with the beginning of the semester.
- 28 signifies a second 8-week course which starts in the middle of the semester.
- 14 signifies a 14-week course, also known as a "late start", which begins 2-weeks after the semester starts.

Summer courses can be taken in 8-week classes or 4-week classes. Below are the identifiers for the FIRST two digits of the section number which identifies course duration.

- 08 signifies a course for the whole 8-week summer term
- 04 signifies a first 4-week session
- 24 signifies a second 4-week session

Winter courses are 4-week classes and all online. The code for all winter classes will be 4440.
