TRiO Student Support Services (SSS) is a federally funded program that offers extra support and assistance for 140 qualified students each academic year. To be eligible for the TRiO Student Support Services Program, a student must meet one of the following requirements: 1) The student is a first-generation college student (neither parent has earned a bachelors degree); 2) The student meets low-income status; or 3) the student has a physical or learning disability. The SSS staff wants to help students succeed in reaching their academic and career goals. Many of the program students are experiencing college life for the first time. Special efforts to encourage, inspire, and strengthen students' academic performance is a high priority for the SSS staff. The SSS's mission is to increase the graduation and transfer rates of students. The program offers both one-on-one and group-based services. All of the services are free for program participants.

The SSS's mission is to increase the graduation and transfer rates of students. The program offers both one-on-one and group-based services. All of the services are free for program participants.
