Dear Dr. Kinlaw:

As you might recall, SACSCOC is developing a student completion information database to research and identify strategies that may effectively increase student achievement at our member institutions. Additionally, this undertaking is in part a response to directives from the U. S. Department of Education regarding student success. In May 2017, we asked your institution (i) to select a student completion indicator (i.e., the NSC total completion rate; the IPEDS graduation rate; or the completion rate calculated from the data provided in the SACSCOC Annual Enrollment Profile) and (ii) to identify a set of peer schools to contextualize institutional performance on the selected student completion indicator.

The table below presents data on the indicator your institution selected. In addition, the table shows the average performance of the peers your institution selected on the same metric. Evaluation committees for the Fifth-Year Interim Reports and reaffirmation committees will use this information as background, contextual reference points to inform their reviews (e.g., core requirement 8.1 – student achievement).
