Registration Cost: \$180

Learn aspects of developing a computer program. Analyze problems, create pseudocode and flow charts, and ultimately create a functioning program to solve those problems. Students learn to correct and execute programs, apply effective programming techniques to prepare business reports, and create and maintain data files. Students do not need a strong technical or math background to succeed in this course.

The course is delivered online and meets virtually one night per week. Tuition prepayment (\$180) is required.
