Comments:

- The North Carolina State Board of Nursing offers a Nurse Licensure Compact (NLC) agreement which allows mutual recognition of a nursing license with 35 states (2 more states pending in 2023) for nurses trained in NC to practice in member states.
- ADN licensure requirements vary by state and other individual factors; credentials, training, job experience, criminal history or military service.
- Student applications are reviewed on a case-by-case basis. All ADN graduates will take a standardized exam nationwide. It is administered through the National Council of State Boards of Nursing. For more information visit <u>www.ncsbn.org</u>.
