Comments:

- While most cardiovascular monitoring technicians seek voluntary certification, no state requires cardiovascular monitoring technicians to be licensed.
- Most states <u>do not</u> have a formal education requirement for cardiovascular monitoring technicians.
 Formal cardiovascular monitoring technicians training programs are available from community colleges, vocational schools, and technical institutes.
- Formal cardiovascular monitoring technician programs typically lead to either a certificate or a diploma. They do not confer any type of cardiovascular monitoring technician's license. Cardiovascular monitoring technicians are not required by law to hold licensure or certification.
- Cardiovascular monitoring technicians are not typically a state-licensed/certified profession. This means
 that cardiovascular monitoring technicians do not typically need specific credentials to practice in the
 field. There are no standardized requirements across all 50 states for the cardiovascular monitoring
 technicians' program.
- Students may be required to pass a background and drug screening in addition to certification, licensing, and or state registration for more information review state laws.
