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
FALL 2023 ENROLLMENT FACTS

- A total of 1,786 students enrolled during the fall of 2023. This is an increase of 3% from the fall of 2022, but a decrease of 11% from the fall of 2019.
- Of these students, 55% are seeking an associate degree, 5% are seeking a diploma, 1% are seeking a certificate, 18% are enrolled in Early College High School, 20% are Career and College Promise, and 1% are seeking special credit.
- Career and College Promise enrollment is up 2% from the fall of 22 and 7% from the fall of 2019.
- The Total Enrollment by Division table should not be used for comparison of divisions from year to year due to a reorginization of programs in the fall of 2021.
- A total of 1,127 (63.1%) students are female, compared with 1,117 (64.7%) in 2022 and 1,232 (65.2%) in 2021.
- The current average age is 21.7, compared to 21.9 in fall of 2022 and 22.5 in the fall of 2021.
- Most of our students are from Rockingham County with 84% (1,498) listing it as their county of residence. Guilford County makes up 7.2% (128) and Caswell makes up 2.5% (44) of our fall 2023 enrollment.
- The largest percent of our students are from Reidsville with 38% (681) listing it as their city of residence. Eden makes up 20% (363), Madison makes up 7.8% (140), and Stoneville makes up 8.5% (151) of our fall 2023 enrollment.
- First-time Freshman enrollment is up 10% from the fall of 2022, but down 21% from the Fall of 2019.



TOTAL ENROLLMENT BY DEGREE SOUGHT FALL TERMS 2019-2023




